August 4, 2005

Board Members Present: Judy Vitanvas, Nancy Bowen, Dave Hayes, Elbert Traylor, Jennifer Brown, Beverly McGhghy, Vince Kamrath and Hope Sass.

1. Minutes: No Board meeting was held in July due to the GLOC July Picnic.
2. Agility:
 - a. The agility equipment has been removed from the State Fair building which is being rented for agility practice. The building will again be available after the State Fair. The agility equipment will be used for the County Fair on Sunday 8/7/05 and is presently parked in front of GLOC. Due to possible inclement weather, we may need to purchase a tarp to cover the equipment. Elbert will look into purchase of a tarp if needed.
 - b. Trailer. The possibility of purchasing a trailer for sale by a club member's family member was discussed. The trailer is wired as a concession stand and has a glass opening on one side. The purchase of the trailer was not approved. Elbert will determine pricing of utility type trailers.
 - c. NADAC. The Agility Committee has requested GLOC to seek approval to hold approval to hold North American Dog Agility Club (NADAC) agility trials. The Committee reports no new agility equipment will be needed. Mixed breed dogs can participate in NADAC trials and more of our club members could compete. This request was approved.
 - d. Agility Seminar. The 2005 agility seminar held earlier this summer by GLOC profited about \$200.
 - e. Classes: The 7/10 agility class has been rescheduled.
3. Treasurer's Report – approved. See elsewhere in this issue of The Barker.
4. GLOC Seminars: A suggestion to alternate seminars each year. Since there was an agility seminar in 2005, GLOC will plan an obedience seminar to be held in 2006. This was approved.
5. Correspondence Secretary (provided by Janet Ball): Condolences were sent to Marcy, Alicia and Vicky Grayball, whose mother passed away. A sympathy card was sent to Vince Kamrath on the passing of Chelsea, (Shetland Sheepdog); Chelsea and Vince had previously earned their UDX.
6. Flyball: We received a request from a flyball group in Lincoln that is interested in pursuing the possibility of also using the State Fair building that GLOC currently rents. Board Members were favorable, but Beverly will obtain more information prior to a final decision.
7. Training: Basic classes are doing very well. Open and Utility classes were cancelled due to lack of interest.
8. Non-Profit Status: The Lincoln office verified our Tax ID number and have forwarded our correspondence to Cincinnati for response.
9. Instructors: Incentives for instructors were discussed. This was deferred until more details have been worked out.
