**BOARD MEETING MINUTES
March 3, 2005**

Treasurer's Report: See elsewhere in this issue of The Barker. A correction was also made to the February report.

Insurance: Vince reported that our six-month premium for commercial insurance was \$737.50. We will be getting back \$405 for overpayment. Judy has not had time to review the insurance information received from AKC. It appears it would be approximately \$700 per year, but she will need to determine what this could cover.

Audit Committee: The Audit Committee (Jodie Hiskey and Mary Kramer) audited the GLOC financial accounts on February 24, 2005. Everything was in order and the Auditing Committee commented on the orderly bookkeeping system maintained by Vince Kamrath, Treasurer.

Training: In order to maintain consistency in pricing of classes, future classes have been repriced so they average \$6.50 per hour. Rather than a flat \$10 discount for members, the Board approved a 25% discount.

Membership Listing Update: A notice will be placed in the Barker requesting members to notify Dave Hayes if they have moved or changed telephone numbers. Vince will sent post cards to delinquent members notifying them they must pay their dues renewals on or before the April 7th meeting.

Agility, Fall Trial 2005: Judy has received the judge's contract for the fall agility trial.

Agility Seminar: GLOC will be sponsoring an Agility Seminar with Lori Michaels on June 11-12, 2005.

Obedience:
