All entries must be original copies submitted on official AKC Agility Entry Forms (attached), one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the AKC agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and will not be entered in the trial (AKC Rule Ch. 14, Sec. 4). Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must: 1) include postage or be metered; and 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS and DHL. Please waive signature requirements on all forms of delivery. Mail requiring signatures will be returned to sender. A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than ten entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned. No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries.

Entry Opening Date: August 9, 2010, 8 a.m.

Final Closing Date: September 24, 2010, 5 p.m., after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules.

Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each titling class: Novice A & B, Open, and Excellent A & B, Standard, JWW, Regular, and Preferred. Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score in each titling class. A multi-colored ribbon and label pin will also be offered to all dogs finishing an agility title at these shows. Competitors earning a qualifying score in both Excellent B Std & Excellent B JWW (Double Q) will receive a rosette. Competitors earning a MACH will receive a commemorative rosette, and a MACH pole.

RUNNING ORDER AS FOLLOWS: Saturday 26", 24", 20", 16", 12", 8" & 4" dogs. Sunday 4", 8", 12", 16", 20", 24", & 26" dogs.

CLASS ORDER AS FOLLOWS: Excellent Standard (Regular & Preferred), Open Standard (Regular & Preferred), Novice Standard (Regular & Preferred), Excellent Jumpers (Regular & Preferred), Open Jumpers (Regular & Preferred), and Novice Jumpers (Regular & Preferred).

OBSTACLES

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current list of Mandatory Obstacles.

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on soccer turf.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM UP

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. Only handlers entered in the class will be permitted on the course. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. There will be NO contact obstacle familiarization at these trials.

Height Divisions

Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height. Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time MUST enter at the NOVICE level in Preferred Standard and Preferred JWW. The above jump heights under the preferred column must be used in all Preferred Classes.

NEW SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are a registerable breed that has obtained an AKC, ILP, PAL, or AKC Canine Partners listing number.

Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with the AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

ROUTES TO SHOW SITE

From the Northeast and Northwest: Exit I-80 at US-77 South/Homestead Expy / Salt Valley Roadway toward Beatrice. Continue on US-77 for 3 miles and then take the ramp right for Van Dorn Street toward Lincoln. Turn left onto S 6th St and then turn right onto Hill St. Arrive at Bison Sports Complex on the left.

From the Southeast: Enter Lincoln on NE-2W/ J Sterling Morton Beltway and continue onto S 10th St. Turn left at Hill St. Arrive at Bison Sports Complex on the right.

From the South: Take US-77 to the Van Dorn St exit toward Lincoln. Turn left at 6th St and then turn right at Hill St. Arrive at Bison Sports Complex on the left.

ALL ATTENDEES MUST COMPLY WITH LINCOLN, NEBRASKA, CITY WASTE
DISPOSAL ORDINANCE:

6.08.155 Disposal of Dog Waste.

Any person having custody or control of any dog shall have the responsibility for disposing of dog feces or manure of the dog in a sanitary manner. The provisions of this section shall not apply to law enforcement officers while using the dog to perform law enforcement functions or rescue activity. It shall be unlawful for any person having custody or control of any dog to place, deposit, discard, or dispose of feces or manure on public property or private property of another unless placed in approved garbage or refuse containers on public property or with the consent of the owner of the private property. (Ord. 18092 §66; November 18, 2002).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Greater Lincoln Obedience Club, Inc., and AKC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or death sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s). Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

Trial Site will be available after 1 p.m. Friday and 6:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. This trial will be held indoors on soccer turf. Bring chairs, crates, and clean up tools. Water and food vending are available on site. Dogs must be removed from the trial site upon completion of the trial. Overnight RV parking or camping is not available at the site.

No refunds will be given for bitches that come in season after the closing date of the trial, nor will they be given in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots or civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made. GLOC reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Indoor crating space is limited. No ex-pens will be permitted inside the building. Crating may be left in the building overnight. Crate mats or tarps are required under crates on the soccer field.

No Food or beverages will be allowed on the soccer floor surface.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.
