



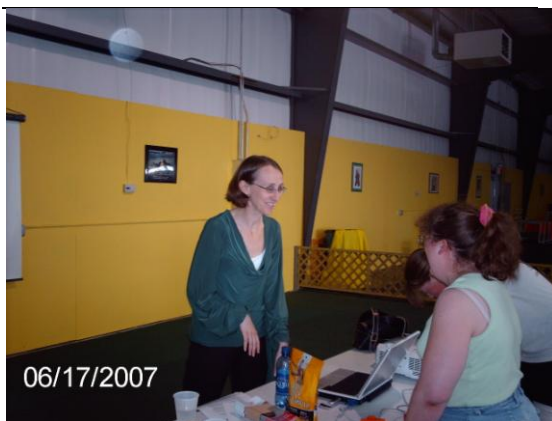
ANNOUNCEMENTS

**Minutes: GLOC Board Meeting
June 7, 2007**

Attending: Staci Sullivan, Janet Ball, Elbert Traylor, Nancy Bowen, Mary Schweitzer, Cheryl Griffith, Jayne Seby, Judy Vitamvas, Georgia Davis, Jennifer Brown, Vince Kamrath.

Minutes of the May 3, 2007 Board meeting were approved with corrections. Under New Business item b., AKC, not UKC as stated in the minutes, offers the agility “fast class”. Georgia Davis corrected the listing of her email address. It is gdavis2@neb.rr.com

Janet announced that this June meeting is the one-year anniversary of GLOC being in the Johanna Street building.

Treasurer’s Report: Jayne Seby reported income of \$2,187 and expenses of \$3,360 for the month. For the year of being in the building, we have an income of approximately \$54,000 and expenses of \$58,000 for a loss of \$4,000 for the year. This is the month in which our rent increases and we begin paying the utilities for the building. Judy Vitamvas was elected to be our registered agent for our state corporation designation.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Correspondence: Cheryl Griffith reported that AKC has charged us \$80 for lateness of the October agility trial application. The Friday (10/5/07) agility trial is approved by AKC. An application for the spring 2008 agility trial was received by GLOC. The AKC agility chairperson sent a letter to GLOC with a summary of necessary changes to the agility equipment. The changes are minor, mostly involve increasing the grit content of the paint, and are being worked on.

Agility: No report.

Awards: No report.

Building: Nancy Bowen reported a whopping income of \$12 from recycling the pop cans. She has received no responses from her request for volunteers to help with the building but that may be due to club members not yet receiving the Barker.

Fall Obedience Trial: Janet reported that everything is “cool” for the October trial. One judge backed out but a replacement judge has already been found.

Public Relations: Cheryl Griffith reported that we have been invited by the Lincoln Area Agency on Aging to do a demonstration/booth on 6/16/07 but we have to pay \$30. We voted to not spend the money on this event.

Training: Elbert Traylor reported a need for Tuesday and Wednesday instructors.

Flyball: Staci Sullivan described the new flyball class. It has 3-4 students. The flyball team received very positive feedback on the tournament. The tournament made approximately \$500. Congratulations to the flyball team and the GLOC member volunteers who had a crash course in flyball.

OLD BUSINESS

Janet Ball has contacted Goodyear to inquire about restarting getting mats for the floor.

Competition Trials

- a. UKC agility trials – The revised results have been sent to the UKC.
No ribbons will be sent out until the UKC reviews the results.
- b. UKC obedience trial – All results are in and the trial is complete.
- c. Flyball tournament – All results are in.
- d. AKC agility trial – All reports are in and confirmed.
- e. Fall agility trial – Application was turned in late. Jennifer Brown is the trial chair.

Janet Ball proposed creating a Competition Manager to track preparations and schedules for the various trials. This proposal will be presented to the general membership. Jayne proposed that the vice president position be chair of a standing committee on competitions. The committee will include the trial chairpersons who will provide checklists of the details of their competition. This proposal was unanimously approved.

Cheryl and Dave Griffith volunteered to make sure all agility equipment conforms to AKC standards. Jennifer Brown is the fall trial chair and has created a detailed schedule of preparation for the event.

There is an obedience show-n-go scheduled for 6/15/07. Janet Ball will chair this event. There is an agility show-n-go scheduled for 6/22. Jennifer Brown is the chair and Cheryl Griffith is the judge.

Janet Ball inquired about the extent of the GLOC “hold harmless” release from liability. Jayne responded that class registration forms and membership applications have this release included.

Vince reported he has been contacted by a flyball team from Omaha as an inquiry about renting the GLOC building for a tournament. Fees were discussed.

The meeting was adjourned.

Minutes of the May 2007 were approved.

Treasurer’s Report: Jayne Seby reported a loss of \$3740 for the year of being in the new building. This figure includes the one-time cost of the new agility equipment and is roughly equivalent to that amount.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Correspondence: Cheryl Griffith reported AKC approval of the April 2008 agility trial. The Friday portion of the October 2007 (10-5-07) has also been approved by AKC. The AKC agility director sent a letter detailing the modifications needed to the new agility equipment. There were no surprises in this letter and the changes are under way.

Awards: Jennifer Brown. No report.

Building: Nancy Bowen thanked Jerry Petersen for his volunteer service of mowing the north lawn. She also thanked Elbert Traylor et al. for installing the office divider panels. Nancy also described the breed flag project to decorate the upper reaches of the building and show off the variety of breeds and types of dogs that participate in GLOC. She asked that members donate a flag in the 24” X 36” size range (or thereabouts) that depicts their breed of dog. Nancy will hang the flags around the building on the gray steel wall braces. The following flags have been donated/ordered: Golden Retriever, smooth and long hair Chihuahua, black and white Border Collie, Sheltie. Delores Giebenrath suggested the internet-accessed www.yourbreedstore.com as a good resource. Type in your dog breed and all kinds of available “stuff” comes up.

Agility: Marcy Graybill reports that everything is “okay” with agility. Equipment modifications, mostly using more gritty paint, are progressing. She reminded all members that classes should be cancelled if the temperature is 100 degrees at 5:00 pm.

Public Relations: Alicia Graybill reported no news yet on the Star City Parade. A demonstration is scheduled for 6-16-07 at St. Mark’s United Methodist church.

Training: Elbert Traylor reported that new flyers are available for July classes and asked that members help to distribute those flyers. An obedience show-n-go is scheduled for 6-15-07 and Janet Ball is the chair. Please volunteer to ring steward at these Friday show-n-go events.

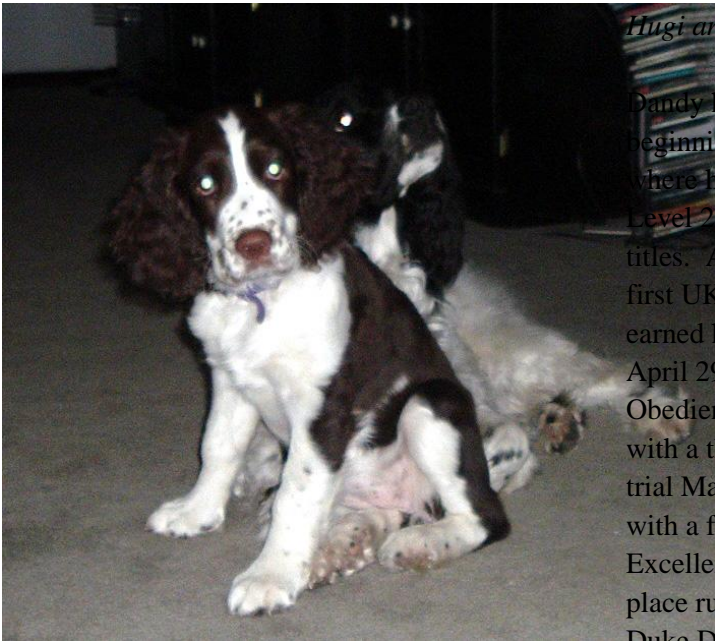
