GLOC Board Meeting Minutes

General Meeting Minutes, June 6, 2019

General meeting, present was: Rod and JuLee Vincent, Teresa Barney, Kat Pothoff, Robin Bonge, Jessica Bruns, Katie Schwartz, Alicia, Evangeline, Jennifer Brown, Jeannine Beers, Pam Eckstein, Lynette Nelson, Kathy Zupancic, Rosalie Claussen, Megan Zawacki, Avery Barney

The Barker was distributed on the 24th of May. Judy firsts, Evangeline seconded, to approve the minutes, motion passed.

We will be getting the money from SCC, paperwork was all sent in, though we sent March paperwork in early, they say it wasn't received, so this was the holdup for the funds, but now has been turned in and we're just waiting for the check. Total coming from SCC for the amount of \$18,200.00 winter funds and spring funds of \$1820.

Treasurer's report from Jeannine: May, income was \$2745.23; expenses were 11,693.23, including 2 months of rent; also bought \$343 of equipment. Cash flow for the month was negative \$8,894.00; our checking acct balance

\$49,394.45; we have a float of negative \$5,588.48, this includes a rent check. Funds on hand are \$43,805.97, toss back into that \$18,000 and we're back up to usual about \$60,000. Income we had \$375 from the NADAC trial; from our \$206 from the agility fun match, and \$105 the Obedience fun match. Alicia firsts to accept the treasurer report, Katie seconds, motion passes.

Sports director report - Kat Our AKC Trial is next weekend, June 14, 15 & 16, will load the truck on Thursday night, can't unload until 9 at Speedway Village. You can set up your crate the night before if you come out Thurs. evening. Food on Sunday will be coordinated by Pam. Teresa stated we will have sandwiches Friday and Saturday, volunteers can eat. No outside food allowed in the venue. We can unload into the doorway/entryway possibly when we get there, Jeannine will check on this. Volunteers need to be there Friday AM at 7:30. Please come out, it is going to be a lot of fun, and volunteers are very much appreciated. We will wing the volunteers for our trial, per Jessica. After June, we have our October trial, Kyle is handling this, he is at Nationals right now, also Kerri Paulsen, Carrie Johnstone, and Sherry Tomes.

Robin and Sherry are working on the November trial.

NADAC, no plans at this time, earliest for a trial will be late Sept/Oct. We've had requests for more Flyball classes, will schedule this in upcoming sessions expect this will be on Thursday night where we have room, and with committed individuals. Scent work we have our CPE application in, Pam and Robin are co-chairs for this, and closing for this is July 9th. Premium is sent in, but not approved yet, if you have a CPE number, you can go ahead and register, there has been interest on FB, from Iowa and Kansas and South Dakota and Missouri. If you are interested, talk to Kat or Pam about classes, it is recommended that you sign up for a class, to review and have practice.

We are excited that we are going to be the among the first to offer these, (Scent Sport is the official name), as Nebraska was also the first in starting CPE Agility trials. Get your entries in, it is first come first served, the premium will tell you when entries are accepted, July 9th, these possibly can be accepted later than this depending on space.

Please be aware of what equipment is new, and only to be used for trials, use the other older equipment for classes, these are separated now, so please check when you take equipment out to use.

Registration for classes for the next session, this will be put out on FB and by email. We will talk to Eric about opening this early, as it is not always open at 6, and people try to register and can't. Suggesting that he open it early, and you would know that if you register early, it will be thrown away. But then after 6 anyone could register at 6, it would be open.

Huge thanks to everyone from Kat, who is helping and volunteering with classes, it takes a lot to keep our club going. Kat reported that at least 27 people have assisted either teaching or assisted in obedience; 18 in agility. And in some classes everyone has pitched in to run the class themselves, this has been working well. Also have appreciated those who have subbed in classes, overall quite a lot of people have helped. And hoping we will get volunteers for Session 5, although there are no agility classes, also people are gone in the summer, but it is always appreciated, and allows our club to function. Kudos to everyone! Session 5 and 6 are now posted, thanks in advance to those who sign up to help.

Barnhunt, Pam reported they tried to have this last Sunday, but didn't work out, Lynette asked if we are ever going to have a trial in this, Pam explained that Barn hunt is more of a challenge to run this, is a lot of physical work, with the straw, this makes it hard to set these up. Would be helpful if we could get some college guys to help with this. Besides the manpower, it is 18

mos. to 2 yrs. until having a pretrial, or test trial, other requirements, but is harder to get this going. A lot of hoops we have to jump through, we haven't had the judge, or trial secretary etc., we had a cold wet spring, have to think about the rats health, and now it's hot, etc.

Corresponding secretary - Megan no new cards sent. Suggesting a card sent to Judy Vitamvas, being sick also Cricket passed away; send a card to Teresa for Baxter having medical issues. Introduction of a new member attending tonight, Janet ???

We will reschedule the June Board Meeting for some time after our AKC trial.
