The expenses were the 1st quarter sales tax; approx. \$600 for ribbons and \$500 for tax preparation. A motion to approve the treasurer's report was made by Leath M and seconded by Alicia G. Motion carried.

Corresponding Secretary: Alicia reported not receiving correspondence. Kat advised GRRIN sent a thank you for allowing use of the building for their annual meeting in April.

Training Director: Alicia reported that classes are going well and there are fewer classes offered during the summer.

Sports Director: Kat P and Judy V reported for the AKC June trial that the truck is reserved, the motel is reserved and that if anyone wants to volunteer to shadow the trial secretary table to see how to run the show. Thursday June 15th, we will load the truck and unload and set the course at 6 pm. All willing volunteers to help load, unload and set up will be appreciated. October 6,7,8 will be our next AKC trial, Chris S and Danielle G are trial chairs and Lisa Black the trial secretary. November 25-26 is our CPE trial with Robin Bonge as trial chair.
