Email confirmations will be sent to those providing a legible email address on their entry form. If you would like to receive your entry status by USPS prior to the issuance of the preliminary judging schedule at closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry.

- Only one dog per entry form, include AKC titles only.
- All entries must be original copies submitted on official AKC Agility Entry Forms (attached) and must include an attached signed AKC agreement. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are **NOT** acceptable and will not be entered into the trial (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 4).
- Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted.
- Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must: 1) include postage or be metered; and 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier services, including, but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. Please waive signature requirements on all forms of delivery. **Mail requiring signatures will be returned to the sender.**
- A maximum of ten (10) entries per envelope are allowed. Envelopes with more than ten (10) entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.
- No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing/email by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries.
- Make checks out to **Greater Lincoln Obedience Club (GLOC)**.
- A returned check charge of \$35 will be leveled.
- Move ups (prior to trials) will be accepted until **October 2, 2023** at 5 pm CT.
- Day to day move ups will be accepted and must be provided to the Trial Secretary in writing at the trial site not later than the day preceding the event.

Online Entry

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated online or paper will be as follows: 175 runs online (50%), 175 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either. Mixed class/height entries may require paper entry to avoid overpayment.

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries After Closing Date/Time

A wait list will be kept until Monday, September 28, 2020 to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the wait list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled, but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the wait list close date will receive a full refund.

Ribbons and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place – Blue

Second Place – Red

Third Place – Yellow

Fourth Place – White

Qualifying Score – Dark Green

A new title ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH or PACH rosette and decorated MACH or PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that achieve their MACH or PACH. Double and Triple Q rosettes will be awarded.

Directions To The Trial Site

Lancaster Event Center, 4100 N 84th St, Lincoln, NE

From the Northeast and Northwest: Exit I-80 at Exit 409 (Waverly). Continue west on Cornhusker Hwy to 84th St. Turn left on 84th St. Continue 1.5 miles to Lancaster Event Center on the left.

From the South: Take NE Hwy 2 to NE Hwy 2/Nebraska Parkway to 84th Street. Turn north onto 84th street and continue 8.2 miles to Lancaster Event Center on the right.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Privileges (PAL/ILP), and AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors, air-conditioned facility on soccer turf. Ring size will be 100' x 110'.

Course Walk-Throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. Only handlers entered in the class will be permitted on the course. Walkthroughs may be limited to 25 handlers. If multiple walkthroughs are required for a class, they will be back-to-back and there will be no 5 minute countdown clock.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training the dog.

Notice to Exhibitors

Food: Limited concessions may be available on site, and fast food restaurants are within 1 mile of the **Trial Site**. Food trucks possible.

Trial Site will be available after 7:00 AM Friday, Saturday and Sunday. This trial will be held indoors on packed dirt. Bring chairs, crates, and clean-up tools. Dogs must be removed from the trial site each day upon completion of the trial.

Indoor crating space is available on concrete. No ex-pens will be permitted inside the building. Bring chairs, crates, and clean-up tools. Dogs must be removed from the trial site each day upon completion of the trial..

Rules Changes: For Exhibition Only (FEO) entries in T2B and FAST and mixture of classes & jump heights is allowed at this trial per AKC change notice effective January 1, 2020. Fix and Go (FNG) is allowed. See AKC rules for details. FEO and FNG result in a non-qualifying score (NQ).

Safety, Behavior and Liability

- **By entering this trial**, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- The Greater Lincoln Obedience Club and AKC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or death sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s).
- Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.
- **All dogs** must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or in the designated warm-up area. Lincoln requires all dogs to be on a leash or confined outdoors.
- **Exhibitors** are expected to **dispose of dog feces or manure in a sanitary manner**.
- **Crates** may be left overnight; however, the Greater Lincoln Obedience Club and Lancaster Event Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- By entering this trial you are releasing GLOC and the trial facility from any impact or consequences of Covid-19. Be kind, respectful and do your part to ensure safety of yourself and other trial attendees.
- **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **All dogs on site MUST belong to an entered competitor.**

Refunds

- **Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete.** Entry fees less \$6.00 administrative fee and applicable AKC Recording fees per day (\$3 per run entered) will be refunded for bitches coming in season after the closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.
- **Refunds (less \$6.00 administrative fee and applicable AKC Recording fees per day (\$3 per run entered)) for all other reasons will be considered on a case-by-case basis t=by the GLOC board. Request for refunds must be submitted via email to gloctrialdirector@gmail.com within 7 days of the last day of the rial. Include rationale and any supporting documentation. Decissions will be provided after the next GLOC board meeting (typically the first Thursday of the month).**
- **No refunds** will be given in the event a dog or handler is disqualified or excused by the judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- If, because of riots or civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.
- Greater Lincoln Obedience Club reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

Ringside

- **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their classes if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. The exhibitor's instructions will state if a VMO or AKC Field Rep All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- When filling out the entry form, there is a check box for exhibitors to designate if their dog needs to be measured. If you dog needs to be measured, please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows to include your dog in the Dogs To Be Measured List. If a VMO or AKC field Reg is present and measuring, dogs must be measured if they
 - Are under 2 years old and do NOT have a temporary height card (only obtained by VMO measurement)
 - Are over 2 years old and do not have at least one VMO measurement
 - You are responsible for ensuring your dog is entered in the appropriate height, if no measuring occurs during the trial.
- **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- **Agility Gate** will be used for check-in and monitoring the run order. Every effort will be made to space dogs run by the same handler in the same class. A paper copy of the run order will be posted but not updated for day of show conflicts.
- **Course Maps** will be distributed electronically before the trial start. One set will be posted at the trial

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
