The large white building is on your left, enclosed by chain link fencing and the signage reads Companion Dog Club. (Please note: your GPS will tell you it's on the east side of the street, but the building is actually on the **WEST** side.)

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that GLOC considers the entire motel and grounds to be within the trial limits. You will be responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the motel/ adjoining grounds will be brought to the attention of the Trial Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

Attention Exhibitors

The show site will be available to exhibitors one hour before the start of judging each day. The building will be closed and dogs must be removed from the show site each day within 30 minutes of the completion of judging.

Telephone, e-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Make all checks and money orders payable to Greater Lincoln Obedience Club (GLOC). Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds.

Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Mail all entries to Norine Nieman, 13500 Spring Street, Omaha, NE 68144. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Confirmation of entries will be made as soon as possible after received. Please check your confirmation for accuracy, especially your dog's registration number, and let the secretary know immediately if you find any errors.

Unless an exhibitor specifically requests postal communication, submission of an e-mail address on the entry form will serve as authorization to send communication, including entry confirmation, via e-mail. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their e-mail software will accept messages from papnoseNN@gmail.com.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee or AKC. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.

GLOC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

Owners are responsible for errors on completed entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or e-mail prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. Refunds will not be given for changes to an entry, however, exhibitors may write a new check.

Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check.

No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Bitches in Season are not permitted at the trial. Full refunds are given for bitches that come into season after closing as long as the trial secretary is notified prior to the start time of the trial and a written verification by a veterinarian is provided.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Class prizes will be distributed in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims must be made in the ring before the judging for that show is over, and the Secretary advised at once. All prizes must be claimed at the show. If not, they become the property of GLOC. No prizes will be mailed.

GLOC, the show secretary, members of the show committee, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, their employees or children, etc. or to any of their dogs or property. Entrants and spectators to this show do so entirely at their own risk.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. GLOC reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly by any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
