#### Entry Information

The AKC Temperament Test is a pass or fail, non-competitive test that assesses a dog's reaction to stimuli frequently encountered in the environment. The test assesses reaction to social stimuli, auditory, visual, and tactile stimuli, proprioceptive (motion) stimuli, and unexpected stimuli.

Dogs may wear slip collars that are on the "dead ring", buckle collars, martingales, and body harnesses. **Dogs may not wear prong collars, e-collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog.** Leashes should be 4 to 6 inches long and made of fabric or leather.

#### Dogs Eligible to Enter

All dogs twelve (12) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Privileges (PAL/ILP), and AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate but will be scheduled only as the last dog(s) at the end of the event.

#### Wait List for Withdrawn Entries After Closing Date/Time

A wait list will be kept until Friday, October 7, 2022 to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the wait list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available.

**By entering this trial you are releasing Greater Lincoln Obedience Club and the trial facility from any impact or consequences of Covid-19. Be kind, respectful, and do your part to ensure safety of yourself and other trial attendees.**

## Arrival for Testing

- **Building will open at 8:30**
- **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to 30 minutes before their testing time.
- Evaluators are not required to wait for dogs.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the club when it is their time to test.
